

## 2019 Edward Carlton Holmes Memorial Scholarship

Edward (Ned) Carlton Holmes, formerly of Matahiwi, near Masterton, was a leading figure in the community. He had strong links with local Māori as a benefactor and friend.

The Māori Education Trust scholarship programme comprises a range of scholarships for Māori secondary and tertiary students. The purpose of the scholarship programme is to provide support for Māori students to pursue and achieve success in programmes of study and training.

### ELIGIBILITY

Applicants applying for the Edward Carlton Holmes Memorial scholarship must:

- i. be a registered beneficiary of the Ngāti Kahungunu Ki Wairarapa Tāmaki Nui ā Rua Post Settlement Governance Entity (PSGE);
- ii. be enrolled at a New Zealand secondary school in **2019**;
- iii. be attending full-time study for the full year;
- iv. meet all criteria;
- v. submit the application and supporting documentation on time.

1. Incomplete or late applications will not be considered.
2. Additional Information including missing or corrected information, must reach the Māori Education Trust by the closing date.
